

2007 Commemorative Activities at Jefferson National Expansion Memorial (JNEM)
(Not finalized - Subject to change)

January 15, 2007 – Kickoff of Dred Scott Commemoration at JNEM (Old Courthouse/Gateway Arch) will be on Martin Luther King Day.

March 3-4, 2007 – Special weekend commemoration of the Dred Scott Decision at JNEM includes opening of the Dred Scott exhibit at JNEM's Old Courthouse, premiere of new video and launch of special website pages. There will be a special cancellation cachet and day of issuance. Winners of the student writing contest, Dear Mr. Scott, are announced.

March 6, 2007 – The 150th anniversary of the U.S. Supreme Court decision in *Dred Scott v. Sandford* will be remembered with special activities at JNEM include an on-line educational event commemorating the trial's significance from the site where it happened.

May 26, 2007 – Events will take place commemorating the 150th anniversary of the emancipation of the Scotts by Taylor Blow in the Old Courthouse.

June 13, 2007 – Teacher Workshop on Dred Scott

September 17, 2007 – On Constitution Day events commemorating the Dred Scott case and other Civil Rights cases will take place at JNEM.
